## Buckhurst Play Area

Sadly, we start the year with repeated vandalism. We do not think this is mindless vandalism e.g. kicking out the fence. It is considered and must be taking considerable time and potentially use of tools to remove all the uprights from the fence panels. This is now the fifth time this has happened and been repaired by our Open Spaces Team.



The fencing is needed to keep dogs out and stop little ones 'escaping' from the toddler play area.

CCTV and lighting has been suggested but the park does not currently have electricity so would be a considerable investment to enable this. We are considering installing a different kind of mesh fencing to interrupt this ongoing issue / game.

The Mayor has also put out a plea for public to come forward if they know who is doing this.

Following the recently installed new zip wire surface, next week subject to weather we are due to install upgrades to the equipment. We are expecting this to take approximately two weeks to complete.

## Electric Community Bus

Last year, the Town Council obtained grant funding from Kent County Council to purchase an electric Community Bus. This arrived last month and was sent away to be 'wrapped with branding'. The Community Bus will be available for voluntary organisations to hire on a daily hire charge. More information will be available soon on our website.
