Town Team Meeting 17th September 2020

Buckhurst 1 Car Park available for Temporary Use until March 2021

The Town Team was informed at its last meeting held on 19th August 2020 that Sevenoaks District Council were generously offering the use of the Buckhurst 1 Car Park for alternative temporary use until March 2021 as part of the COVID-19 Recovery Plan.

The Wednesday Market would still need to be able to operate.

Sevenoaks Town Council staff have been progressing Licensing arrangements for potential alternative use of the car park.

Normally this would be an exciting opportunity for a permanent base during the festive season for a Christmas Market with traditional wooden huts or maybe even an outdoor ice-skating rink. Town Councillors have discussed the provision of a Christmas Market and believe during COVID-19 and bearing in mind the shortage of time to progress this they would not want to hold this in 2020 but would be interested in 2021 if available. It was also noted that large popular Christmas Markets such as Birmingham had been cancelled this year.

Town Councillors requested that local businesses be asked if anyone had an alternative use for the car park on a temporary basis and to contact Sevenoaks Town Council as soon as possible with their ideas.
