Amendment to Standing Orders: Sealing of Documents

In accordance with Standing Order Requirement, any change to Standing Orders is recommended by one Council meeting to be resolved at the following meeting. At its meeting held on 21st November 2022, the Town Council recommended amendments in relation to the sealing of official documents as set out in the minute below. In line with the Town Council's Standing Orders any changes need to be ratified by two Council meetings, this is the second meeting for consideration:

“442. Standing Orders and Sealing of Documents

Sevenoaks Town Council has the following Standing Order in relation to sealing of official documents. Following Council resolution all sealed documents are consecutively numbered and details entered into the Seal Register which is also signed by the Mayor and Town Clerk.

15 b xviii. Proper Officer

Retain custody of the Seal of the Council (if there is one) which shall not be used without a resolution to that effect

24. Execution and Sealing of Legal Deeds

- a) A legal deed shall not be executed on behalf of the Council unless authorised by a resolution.
- b) Subject to Standing Order 24 a) the Council's common seal shall alone be used for sealing a deed required by law. It shall be applied by the Proper Officer in the presence of two councillors who should sign the deed as witnesses.

From time to time the Town Council via the Mayor is asked to verify residents' documents for overseas pensions etc. Where possible the Town Council will emboss the document without using a seal, however this is not always acceptable to the relevant authorities and a seal is needed.

RECOMMENDED TO FOLLOWING COUNCIL MEETING:

- i) Delegated authority is provided to the Mayor and Town Clerk to 'seal' the personal documents as required subject to a separate register of records being maintained.
- ii) Standing Order 24 b) be amended to reflect current practice as follows:

Town (City) of Sanctuary Accreditation

At the Town Council meeting held on 12th September 2022 it was Resolved to work towards obtaining City of Sanctuary status for Sevenoaks.

On the 30th of November 2022 Cllr Ancrum, Cllr Parry and the Town Clerk met with a representative from the Sevenoaks Welcome Refugees (SWR) to discuss how to progress with the accreditation procedure.

It was agreed that the City of Sanctuary worked on the same principles of 'Blue Flag' demonstrating to public that certain criteria have been met and reviewed independently and demonstrates the town's welcoming attitude and investment for refugees.

There are two types of accreditation

- City of Sanctuary Award
- City of Sanctuary Non-Award

The City of Sanctuary website indicates the Non-Award to be a lesser award and more of an indication of support than practical measures.

It was agreed that the aim would be to obtain the City of Sanctuary Award.

With the aim to have in place for National Refugee Week which was expected to be in June for 2023

In moving forward collaboration would continue between STC, SWR, Churches together and schools.

Initially a shared vision needs to be agreed and submitted. Sevenoaks Welcomes Refugees has the following objectives:

1	The relief of financial hardship amongst those granted and seeking refugee status and their dependents living (temporarily or permanently) in Sevenoaks and the surrounding area.
2	To advance the education and training of those granted and seeking refugee status and their dependents in need thereof so as to advance them in life and assist them to adapt within a new community.
3	To advance the education of the public in general, including landlords and local authorities, on the issues relating to refugees and those seeking asylum.
4	The provision of facilities for recreation or other leisure time occupation with the object of improving the conditions of life of those persons who have need of such facilities by reason of their youth, age, infirmity or disablement, financial hardship, or social and economic circumstances.

5	To develop the capacity and skills of the members of the socially and economically disadvantaged refugee community of Sevenoaks in such a way that they are better able to identify, and help meet, their needs and to participate more fully in society.
