On Saturday 12th July in the Council Chamber of Rheinbach' s celebrated glass museum, an official ceremony took place to mark 25 years of the twinning between Sevenoaks and

Rheinbach. Eleven members of Friends of Rheinbach were present, together with their hosts from Freunde von Sevenoaks, the Bürgermeister of Rheinbach, town councillors and well-wishers. Proceedings opened with some music for violin and piano, played by Julia Maassen and Peter Young. As an older teenager, Julia had been present as part of a string quartet that provided music for the initial signing ceremony in Sevenoaks.

This was followed by a speech by the Bürgermeister to which Peter Young responded by reading a greeting from Cllr Tony Clayton which was then presented to the Bürgermeister.

This was followed by speeches in German and English from Joachim Weiss, chairman of Freunde von Sevenoaks and Peter Young, chairman of Friends of Rheinbach. The Bürgermeister and the two chairmen then signed Rheinbach's Golden Book as an official record of the proceedings. There were also two further musical interludes from Julia and Peter. Proceedings were concluded with refreshments and a convivial time of conversation and reminiscences.
